

UPA Heartfelt Recognition


It is with both sadness and excitement that we announce the retirement of Barbara Lane, Director of Essential Services.

Brain Spine Institute announces Alzheimer's Research Grant Funds

Application Deadline: January 10, 2022

Award Date: March 1, 2022

On behalf of the University of Tennessee Medical Center's Brain & Spine Institute, in conjunction with the University of Tennessee Graduate School of Medicine (UTGSM), it is with great excitement that we are announcing a call for grant applications specifically related to research on Alzheimer's Disease and related dementias.

As a result of a philanthropic initiative chaired by former Regal Entertainment Group and CEO Amy Miles launched on our campus in 2018, we can accept grant applications for Cycle Two of research funding. For this cycle, there are three possible grants based on the size and scope of the project: two grants will be awarded at \$25,000 and one grant at \$10,000. Project funding is for one year but may be extended to a second year, if necessary.

Grant applications are due by Monday, January 10, 2022, at 5:00 PM. The completed application in PDF format should be submitted to Melissa Weaver (mweaver@utmck.edu) or Jennifer Ferris (iferris@utmck.edu) at least 5 days before the deadline to ensure compliance with UTHSC grant submission policy.

The grant applications will be reviewed by the Alzheimer's Research Initiative Scientific Review Committee who will make recommendations for funding to the Alzheimer's Research Initiative Oversight Committee. It is anticipated that applicants will be informed of the results of the grant review by Tuesday, March 1, 2022, with a projected start date of Wednesday, June 1, 2022.
